The Festival format will be similar to previous years - live performances on stage by leading performers from the UK, Ireland and Europe including a visit by our very special guest American guest Daniel Jones.

He began playing pedal steel in the early 70's in the San Francisco area.

He is an honours professor at University of Colorado, Boulder and has his own band playing a wide range of music featuring pedal steel guitar.

A Trade area will be set up to display instruments, sound equipment, accessories, tuition courses, books, CDs, DVDs and tapes.

THE PLAYERS


On stage both days will be Daniel Jones, USA, supported by some of the finest steel players from Europe, UK and Ireland, Under the banner United Steels of Europe we have Mark Horn - Germany. Jean-Yves Lozac'h - France, Koos Biel - Netherlands, Nils Tuxen - Denmark, who play together frequently in Europe. Also from Europe Hans de Jong -Netherlands, Benny Pedersen and Uffe Edefur, a long time supporter of the festival, both from Sweden, Dag Wolf and Egil Skielnes, both from Norway, Jef Marinus, one of Belgium's finest steel players, making his first appearance at the festival and Jani Sandvik from Finland. From England the ever popular Sarah Jory and for his first visit to Ireland, John Davis from Cambridgeshire while Scotland will be represented by Willie Gamble. Ireland will be led by Association members Richard Nelson and Paul Brennan, Jonathan Milligan and Colin Henry. The comperes for the weekend will be Tony McGrath and Pat Orpen both from Waterford.

VENUE & LOCATION

The Green Isle Hotel is situated on the Naas Road (N7 - just off the M50) approximately 20km from Dublin Airport (approx 20 minutes by road) and on a bus route from Dublin City Centre. Directions from Dublin Airport/The North/M50

Leave Dublin Airport and follow signs for the M50 Motorway southbound. Travel about 20km on the M50. Take exit 9 onto the N7 southbound, continue straight through Newlands Cross and take the next exit left marked Kingswood. At the top of the slip road, take the 3rd exit off the roundabout. At the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit & follow the signs for Green Isle Road/Boot Road. Continue along and the hotel is on your right.
